Brenda Ryan Quilt Project: "Stitching Ourselves Together"

Brenda Ryan is designing a quilt for us. Her design is beyond your wildest dreams; fern fronds and grasses as a frame so that people can stitch the names of people, places and things that are important to them. As well, there is an exquisite little possum to stitch, gum nuts and a grass tree. Every quilt will be different as individuals include the things that are meaningful to them.

A number of people have started their quilts. The skill level of participants range from complete beginners to quite experienced stitchers. The beginners have been delighted at how successful their first attempts are. People will be supported through all of the stages of the quilt making process.

If you would like to be involved in the quilt please let me know so that we can cater for you. We have embroidery kits for 30 participants but this could easily be extended if needed. You will be given all of the materials and equipment that you need to complete your own wall-hanging or knee sized quilt or you may prefer to make the panels into cushions or something else like a bag. You can choose to do 1, 2, 3 or all 4 of the panels.
